Free Webinar: Supporting SMEs to save energy

Experiences made in four countries within the EU project GEAR@SME - Registration open

Brussels - The energy crisis with rising energy prices and compliance with climate targets pose major challenges for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs). The EU project GEAR@SME has set itself the task of helping SMEs to save energy and thus reduce costs and set their carbon footprint. In four so-called use cases - in the Netherlands, Germany, Italy and Romania - new approaches were tested and concrete work was carried out with the SMEs.

During the webinar "Supporting SMEs in a collective to save energy - experiences from GEAR@SME" the experiences made on site with the SMEs will be presented and the learnings will be shared. The webinar will explore whether the approaches were successful and what SMEs need today to save energy.
